GENERAL INFORMATION

- the Arena will open at 7:00am on the show day. On Friday the Arena will be open from 6:00pm until 8:00pm for anyone wishing to set up early.
- The Show/Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of shows.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler or run through the building or stands
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must **use the designated areas**.
- Dogs should be in the building 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging and may be removed from the building after their breed. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The Maritime Group 7 Club and Cobequid Dog Club will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.
- A judge officiating at a show held under CKC rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The MG7 Club and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume and liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the MG7 Club and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.

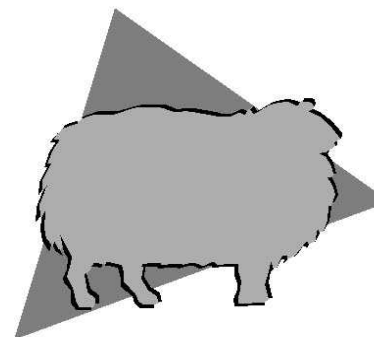

No post dated cheques accepted. All NSF cheques will be Subject to a charge of \$25.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy	12 to 18 Months
Bred by Exhibitor	Canadian Bred	Open
Veterans	Specials Only	Exhibition Only

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed..

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Brace Class – shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps is for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only but not Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.

Senior Class for dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

12-18 Open for dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

Veterans Sweeps is for any dog 7 yrs. of age and up. There will be 4 classes divided by sex:

Veterans 7 - 9 For dogs 7 years up to 9 years

Veterans 9+ For dogs 9 years of age and over

As in Puppy Sweeps the class winners will compete for Best in Sweeps. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps & Best Opposite.

Division of the prize money in Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes will each be as follows:

25% of the total sweepstakes entry fees will be retained for administration.

15% of the total sweeps entry fees in each class will go to the Best in Sweeps.

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of that class

JUNIOR HANDLING

Both Conformation and Obedience junior handling will be offered.

Rosettes – 1st four placings in each Junior & Senior Class. A flat ribbon will be given to all participants/each class. Rosette and prize offered to Best Overall Junior Handler

Juniors MUST handle a dog from Group 7 (Herding)

Please ensure jump heights are indicated on entry form for Open & Utility. A separate entry form is required for each obedience class entered.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Brace Class - is open to any two dogs of either sex that have attained no less than a CD degree in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs, nor they be of the same sex.

Veterans Class - is open to all dogs who have attained an obedience title and are 7 years of age prior to the closing of entries.

Graduate Novice - is open to any dog that has not obtained a qualifying score toward the CDX title in Canada but has earned a CD title.

Champions and Championship Points - Chapter 15

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:
